Established in 1993, Risen Christ Catholic School is grounded in the histories and traditions of our five founding parishes: Holy Name, Holy Rosary, Incarnation, St. Albert the Great and St. Stephen's.

Risen Christ provides a new story for the children of south Minneapolis, many of whom are first or second generation Americans. What might otherwise be unaffordable or unavailable to high-poverty and immigrant families is made possible at Risen Christ to all children whose families seek it.

Risen Christ is the only Catholic dual immersion school in Minnesota and just one of 41 in the nation. This year, Risen Christ is celebrating its 30th anniversary school year!
